MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The August 10, 2020 meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by President, Mike Powers.

Opening ceremonies were conducted.

Roll Call: There were 14 members present

Secretary's Report: The July 2020 minutes were read. There was an amendment made to the July minutes to note that Sue Bolt has not *officially* resigned as our chaplain. Jeni made a motion to accept, Jody seconded the motion and it was carried.

It was agreed that we will be staying with the safety yellow as our color. Keith suggested that, if the cost allows, we keep the shirt purchases local. It was agreed that, if the cost is within a dollar or two, we would purchase locally to keep our money in the community.

Carl reported that there has been no update on the situation with the Loveland's. He will keep us apprised at the next meeting.

New Business: We discussed the upcoming chicken BBQ. Mike asked who planned to volunteer to help that day and several people indicated that they would be there. There was a general plan made for how the drive-thru sales were going to work. It was confirmed that we are purchasing 250 halves rather than the original 400.

We're keeping Jim and Nancy Thall in our thoughts. Jim fell and broke his hip and is now in the Green Home in Wellsboro.

Correspondence: A man named Dennis Christy from Butler County sent us a letter attempting to sell our group lottery tickets for \$20 each. The group decided to table that discussion.
