

TROY AMERICAN LEGION POST 49
MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The December 13, 2021 meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm by President, Mike Powers.

Opening ceremonies were conducted.

Roll Call: There were 16 members and 1 guest present

Secretary's Report: The November Minutes were read. Jody made a motion to accept, Jeni seconded the motion and it was carried.

Treasurer's Report: A full copy of the Treasurer's Report is available to members upon request, if anyone would like to review it.

Road Captain's Report: No Report

Membership Chairman's Report: Carl reported that we have 34 members. We have 22 members paid for 2022, 11 need to pay their 2022 dues and 1 person is in their 2-year window. This puts us at 65% for 2022. Carl will be contacting the members who still owe to find out what their intentions are.

Old Business: Jeni reported that a total of 927 out of 1,000 tickets were sold for the Meat Raffle, for a total of \$4,635. There were expenses of \$91 for the printing of the tickets, \$150 for the freezer and \$450 for the meat. This left a net profit of \$3,944, which is included in our General Fund Balance. The winner of the drawing was Steve Lyon from Troy.

Jeni made a motion that we transfer \$2,000 of the profits from the Meat Raffle to the Relief Fund. Mike Duda seconded the motion, it passed by unanimous vote. A big Thank You to the Duda's for all their work.

Mike Duda is still working on the final details for the Golf Tournament next May. He has the hole sponsor letter ready and will hand them out tonight. He asks that everyone get started on getting sponsors and donations now. He made a motion to have the hole sponsor signs made by Bradco Printers. It was seconded by Carl and it passed.

New Business: There was a request for the Relief Fund from a woman who recently moved to the area. She is in need of financial assistance for Christmas for her daughter and brother whom she is raising. She has stated that her father was a Marine; however, she has no paperwork. It was decided that there are other resources

available to her that are more appropriate for her situation and it was decided that we would decline her request.

Mike Powers brought up having another Meat Raffle in 2022. After a group discussion, it was decided that we would have another Meat Raffle and Jeni would head that up.

Carl brought up changing our meeting nights. Bob said that he felt we should move the meetings back to Sunday. Jeni suggested 3pm at Sunday, but many felt that was too early. It was finally decided to go back to the second Sunday of the month at 6pm. Bob made the motion, Jeni seconded and the motion passed by majority vote, with one descending vote. Our next meeting will be January 9th at 6pm.

Carl brought up Bike Nights in 2022. Jeni made a motion that we hold a Bike Night starting in May, John Duda seconded and the motion carried.

Correspondence: We received Thank You notes from the Troy Fire Department, the Rainbow Riders, Animal Care Sanctuary and the Bradford County Veterans Memorial Park for the donations from the benefit rides this year.
