MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The February 8, 2021 meeting was called to order at 7:05pm by President, Mike Powers.

Opening ceremonies were conducted.

Roll Call: There were 13 members present

Secretary's Report: The January Minutes were read. Bill made a motion to accept, Linda seconded the motion and it was carried.

Treasurer's Report: A full copy of the Treasurer's Report is available to members upon request, if anyone would like to review it.

Road Captain's Report: Bob has spoken with all of our ride beneficiaries with the exception of Chris Boggs for the Bradford County Veteran's Memorial Park, who has not gotten back to him. All participants are excited for rides this summer. Bob will be working on setting dates over the next month.

We still have 2 members in their one-year grace period and 2 in their two-year grace period, for a total of 31 members.

Old Business: The idea of having a single, large ride, benefitting all our current charity ride groups, was discussed again. The overall consensus was that we would stay with individual rides. We will be trying a combination of Saturday and Sunday rides this year to see if Saturday rides generate a higher turnout.

Both short and long sleeve club shirts are now available. Sizes small through X-large are \$15, 2X and larger are \$17 each. Shirts will be available after the meeting. Jeni made a motion that the club absorb the \$60 charge for the shirt artwork rather than pass that on in the cost of the shirts, Linda seconded the motion and it was carried.

New Business: Mike welcomed Mike and Jodi Duda. They come to us from the Jersey Shore ALR. They have several ideas to help our chapter raise funds and we look forward to having them with us.

Correspondence: PA American Legion Housing for Homeless Veterans organization out of Pittsburgh contacted us requesting a donation. Although we all felt that it was a worthy cause, we do not feel that their efforts would focus on assisting veterans in our local communities.

We received a flyer from an ALR Post in Butler County regarding their Annual Fund Raiser which is a raffle for several guns and an Indian motorcycle for \$45. Anyone who is interested can see Carl after the meeting.

We received a Thank You card from our Post for our continued support.
