### MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The May 10, 2021 meeting was called to order at 7:04 pm by President, Mike Powers. Opening ceremonies were conducted.

It was decided that the Riders will donate a \$10 gift certificate for the Vets Club as the prize for each Bike Night game winner. It was also decided that we would purchase flag pins to give away to attendees.

**New Business:** We had a special guest, George Weaver from the Sons of the Legion, who is the chairman for the 15<sup>th</sup> District Fundraiser for homeless veterans. He has

requested that we do a benefit ride as part of their event on August 1<sup>st</sup> in Wyalusing. We agreed. Bob will provide additional details regarding the ride at a future meeting.

Steve let us know about the annual Springman Ride which will be held on July 10<sup>th</sup> leaving from Trout Run.

Jeni handed out cards with contact information for people who have trailers and are willing to help out with disabled bikes.

Mike discussed the Memorial Day Parade. He said that anyone riding should meet at the Baptist Church parking lot at 8:30.
