MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES

The November 8, 2021 meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm by President, Mike Powers.

Opening ceremonies were conducted.

Roll Call: There were 13 members present

Secretary's Report: The October Minutes were read. Linda made a motion to accept, Bill seconded the motion and it was carried.

We will hold our meeting there as well. The Sheffield's address is 45 Water Street in Grover. The club will pay for the deli tray and rolls. The Sheffield's asked that everyone brings their own beverages of choice whether that's water, soda or alcohol. Bob will send out a reminder email to everyone.

Steve mentioned that it was frustrating that the ride beneficiaries did not come get their checks this year. It was decided that we will incorporate a clause in our future ride agreements to set a date, time and place for the check presentation.
