The January 9, 2022 meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm by President, Mike Powers.

Roll Call: There were 14 members present

There will be three prizes this year, first prize will be a freezer with 2 meat bundles, second prize will be 1 meat bundle and third prize will be \$150 cash. There will be 1,000 tickets and the cost will be \$5 per ticket. Ticket sales will start in April and the drawing will be at the November meeting.

New Business: Bruce Johnson let us know that the Towanda Legion is planning a bike trip to Maine this year and our group is invited. He will bring more information to a future meeting.

Correspondence: We received a request from the Mansfield University Student Veteran's Association for a donation. There was concern voiced over the actual status of the organization and it was decided that we would ask Steve Chappell to check into it more before a decision was made.
